Member Code of Conduct



- Wherever possible: preserve, protect, maintain, and enhance the environmental aesthetic and recreational value of trees.
- 2. To ensure that the terminology: "Qualified/General/Student/Corporate Member of the Queensland Arboricultural Association" and in particular; "Qualified Member" and all grades and abbreviations of these qualifications are used **only in conjunction with that member's name**. For example, a member must ensure that his or her employer does not use this qualification in a manner unacceptable to the Association.
- 3. To ensure that members who are authorised to display the QAA logo do so in conjunction with the **Logo Usage Guidelines** provided in your new member pack. Use of the QAA logo is only permitted by Qualified Members or Approved Register Members who have **completed the Logo Usage Training**.
- 4. To the best of your ability and resources, all operations and arborist work is performed in compliance with the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* and the *Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011*. Where possible members will refer to the *Minimum Industry Standards* for best practice guidelines.
- 5. Uphold and embody the maxim and values of the QAA in all possible ways.
